
Vote Planet AGM on Monday September 6

Candidates for the Federal Election

The federal election could be held anytime from 7 August 2021 to April 2022, but is shaping up to look like April next year. There is a 5 week lead-in between the PM calling the election and election day, for nominations to come in and campaigns to begin.

The Vote Planet executive has been fielding candidates from around the country. If you would like to run or know anyone else around Australia who would consider running, please ask them to get in <u>touch</u>. We have support organised to swing into action behind our candidates.

Other microparties and independents

There is a visceral anger across the country that is evident in the 'Voices of' movement springing up in seats where the anger is palpable at the incumbent. It is yet to be seen whether this will translate into voters stepping away from their identity politics and changing how they order their ballot.

Vote Planet has started an communications with other progressive microparties - and there are new ones all the time that we need to reach out to. There is so much to be gained from working with other like minded parties, including awareness raising, helping shape policy and preferencing.

Collaboration also reduces fragmentation of effort and pools resources to support candidates. Additionally, it gives the movement a greater spread of credibility and legitimacy across wider areas.
